- GROUPS WELCOME TO RESUME MEETING IN THE CHURCH ARE:
CRAFTERS, QUILTERS, PRAYER GROUP, SESSION & SESSION TEAMS, AND
AD HOC MEETINGS WITH NO MORE THAN 10 PEOPLE.

MEETING LOGISTICS & GUIDELINES

- ALL MEETINGS MUST BE SCHEDULED IN ADVANCE WITH THE CHURCH OFFICE (456-3243).
- ALL MEETINGS MUST BE SCHEDULED TO BEGIN AND END DURING CHURCH OFFICE HOURS:
MONDAY THROUGH THURSDAY, 8 AM—1 PM
- WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CRAFTERS & QUILTERS,
ALL MEETINGS WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE FELLOWSHIP HALL.
- ONLY ONE GROUP AT A TIME WILL BE PERMITTED TO MEET,
WITH NO LESS THAN HALF AN HOUR BETWEEN SCHEDULED MEETINGS.
- MEETING TIMES WILL BE LIMITED TO 90 MINUTES.

- PARTICIPANTS MUST ADHERE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING (6 FEET) AND WEAR MASKS.
- ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL BE LOGGED IN AND SCREENED BY THE OFFICE MANAGER
—INCLUDING TEMPERATURE READINGS.
TEMPERATURE MUST REGISTER BELOW 100 DEGREES TO ATTEND MEETING.

- PRACTICE AND RECORDING SESSION TIME LIMITED TO 90 MINUTES.
- KEEP A LOG OF PARTICIPANTS AT EACH PRACTICE & RECORDING SESSION.
