## FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF WAYNESVILLE, NC COLLEGE FUND AWARDS PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Generous donors to the First Presbyterian Church of Waynesville, NC's Endowment Fund have directed that a portion of their gifts be designated to provide financial awards for college bound students or students already in undergraduate college/university programs. The Endowment Committee has approved awarding \$500 to eligible students for the 2023-2024 school year. The maximum award for any student is \$2,000 over 4 years. Applicants are required to submit an application and essay <u>each year</u> (see Application on page 2).

The following requirements have been set to guide the church in the decision of who will receive these College Fund Awards. The student:

## 1. Must be:

- A. a Member/Affiliate Member, or a child/grandchild of a Member/Affiliate Member of First Presbyterian Church; **OR**
- B. an Employee or a child/grandchild of an Employee of First Presbyterian Church, subject to the following.
  - i. The employee must be past their probationary period at FPC.
  - ii. If the employee is a full-time high school student, their length of employment will determine the number of years of eligibility for future college fund awards, not to exceed four awards. As an example, if the employee started working at FPC prior to January of their sophomore year of high school and continued working at FPC until high school graduation, they would be eligible to apply for three college awards, as long as they meet the other criteria, as explained below.
- 2. Should demonstrate active participation in a church, the community, and/or school; exhibit leadership qualities and good citizenship.
- 3. Must be accepted or enrolled at an accredited undergraduate level college, university, or school of higher education. If an award is made and the student decides not to attend school, the award must be returned to First Presbyterian Church.
- 4. Must complete an application and write a brief narrative essay answering the 6 questions on the application, page 2. These are to be returned to the church office by August 1, 2023, addressed as follows:

5. Must provide a mobile number and email on the application which will allow us to contact you in September with status of your award. Before any award is issued, contact information will be confirmed.

Once the recipients are announced, we will also be requesting a recent picture for our newsletter. A selfie headshot is perfect and should be emailed to the above address. We will publish information regarding each recipient in a series of articles in our monthly newsletter to keep members abreast of this program.
